## Description of Local Area:

Trafalgar Mews is situated in the centre of Brighton North Laines and is hidden in a secluded mews. The fashionable North Laines area of Brighton offer a wide range of alternative shops, selling handmade clothes, jewellery, skate gear, gifts, and designer clothes to name but a few. There are usually street stalls and markets during the weekends and the atmosphere is lively and young. Trafalgar Street is the largest street in the North Laines with over seventy businesses providing anything from outdoor equipment to second hand books and records as well as many interior design and antique shops. There's even a pottery shop and four good pubs! The top of Trafalgar Street starts under Brighton Station and the bottom ends opposite St Peters Church.

## Journey to School:

The school is a 25 minute walk away or alternatively students can walk to the Old Steine (10 minutes) and from here take buses 7 or 1 directly to the Sussex County Hospital which is a 4 minute walk from the school.

## Description of Residence:

The residence is full of character in its architecture and comprises of two twin rooms and two single rooms all of which offer good storage space and desks for study. There is a bathroom that offers a bath as well as a separate shower cubicle.

The lounge overlooks Trafalgar Street and is a pleasant area for students to socialise and watch television. There is a fully fitted kitchen that includes a washing machine and dryer as well as a microwave. Towels are provided and a change of bed linen will be given when the residence is cleaned.
